

BAC EQUALISER

This is an age related competition where, using specific given formulae, times are re-adjusted to suit the age of the runner.

The best times for the distances are then used and the winning time gets 1 point 2nd gets 2 points and so on.

If the 5 qualifying distances are completed the points gained by the runner are added and the runner with the least points is then adjudged the winner for that year. If only 4 distances are completed then 50 points are added to the runners total, 100 points for 2 distances not completed of the 5 and so on. So obviously the more distances competed in the better the chance to win.

In each year, starting on the 1st January all races are considered for all 1st claim members and their age is also taken as at the 31st December for the preceding year.

Distances used for this are, The Seaside Run, 5k, 5 mile, 10k, 10 mile, half marathon and full marathon. Times can either be runners own line to line time or the official time, whichever is sent to me.

Disputes must be put clearly in writing to the adjudicator(s). Their decision will be final

An update will be found on the Equaliser web-site showing distances run.

The competition operating system will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure correct operation and fair play to all..
